- Assist with field implementation, monitoring, and data collection
- Collaborate with LGAs, CAHWS, and Ward Livestock Officers
- Prepare reports and support project monitoring activities

- At least **one (1) year** of experience working with rural communities
- Strong communication and facilitation skills
- Willingness to work in remote areas
